## Presentation and aims

The Bajo Palabra Philosophy Association of the Autonomous University of Madrid (UAM) has been working throughout the last few years to promote and develop research and scholarly work in Humanities and Social Sciences, particularly in Philosophy, as well as to support its diffusion beyond the academic world. For this reason, and as a natural extension of its activities, last year the Bajo Palabra Philosophy Association undertook the project of a 1<sup>st</sup> Philosophy Conference, entitled "Reflections on a Plural World", with the intention of maintaining the continuity of the project as a periodic, annual event, taking place every winter.

Bajo Palabra Philosophy Association is currently preparing the next edition of the Conference for 2012, which this time will be held the 12, 13, 14, 15 and 16th November 2012, on the UAM Campus, in connection with the inauguration of the UNESCO Chair<sup>1</sup> (whose official denomination, incidentally, is "Philosophy, Human Rights and Democracy", thus perfectly overlapping with the main thematic axis of this year's Edition of the Conference).

Our aim, therefore, is to open a space for exchange, dissemination and collaborative work between people coming from different areas of knowledge, geographical areas, and personal and intellectual experiences. We are inviting students, scholars and researchers from different countries and with different academic backgrounds to exchange the results of their work with each other, at a time when interdisciplinary is more important than ever, and when diversity is the driving force behind every development. Our Conference offers its participants an opportunity to explore the complexities, possibilities and contradictions of present societies from different viewpoints and perspectives.

1 Nowadays, an application for the creation of the UNESCO Chair in the Autonomous University of Madrid has been submitted and is currently in process of receiving approval. The Chair's foundational committee is formed by the following organisms of the UAM: Faculty of Philosophy and Humanities, Faculty of Education, Faculty of Law, Institute of Education Sciences (IUCE) and the Spanish Society of Philosophy Professors (SEPM).

## Sections of the Conference

The 2<sup>nd</sup> *Bajo Palabra-UAM International Philosophy Conference "Philosophy, Human Rights and Democracy"* has its main aim to project the discussion and its conclusions beyond the academic environment and into different areas of knowledge and society. In order to include a wide range of disciplines and research interests, the Conference will be structured along several topics.

The following sections are presented to those researchers interested in presenting a paper (of about 20-30 minutes, including some minutes for debate) in the Conference:

- 8 Human Rights and the New Information and Communication Technologies**
- 9. Multiculturalism: Other perspectives on Human Rights.**
- 10. The Impact of the current world economic crisis on the Welfare State.**

## Publication

Authors of papers presented in the 2<sup>nd</sup> *Bajo Palabra International Philosophy Conference* will receive a copy of the current issue of *Bajo Palabra. Journal of Philosophy*. Participants with accepted papers can submit their complete works (with a length of 12-15 pages) to the Editorial Board of the journal for publication in the next issue. ## 2<sup>nd</sup> Award Competition of Bajo Palabra Journal of Philosophy for Young Researchers

All researchers registered for the Conference, aged 35 or below, and presenting their previously unpublished work on any of the thematic lines of the Conference are eligible for participation. Several prizes will be given to the best works presented by the candidates. The Jury of the Prize will be formed by an international panel of scholars. The criteria for the selection of the winners will be the originality, methodological rigour and precision of the articles proposed by the candidates. The prizes will consist in the publication of the selected articles in an issue of *Bajo Palabra. Journal of Philosophy*, as well as a full refund of the Conference registration fees for their authors.
